

International Refugee Rights Conference : Plan to participate

From 7 to 9 June 2018 the Canadian Council for Refugees invites nongovernmental organizations and others to attend an international conference in Toronto designed to enhance effectiveness in promoting the human rights of refugees and vulnerable migrants.

Conference Program

The conference will take place Thursday 7 - Saturday 9 June, and other sessions are planned on 6 June. We recommend arranging your travel to take part in events on 6 June as well.

Registration

Online registration will open in January 2018.

Participation Costs

While we hope to have some money to subsidize a few participants, especially from the Global South, most participants will need to fund themselves. We encourage you to build the costs into your organization's budget or approach funders to cover the costs.

Travel to Toronto from your location	Depends on location
Canadian visitor visa (if required)	\$100
Biometrics for Canadian visa (if required)	\$85
Travel to apply for Canadian visa (if required)	Depends on location
